

# Useful tools for smaller organisations


The **Employers' Initiative on Domestic Abuse (EIDA)** is a UK charity and membership organisations for employers wanting to take effective action on domestic abuse. EIDA membership is free. ## EIDA's free e-learning resource

EIDA have launched a new, completely free e-learning resource, designed specifically to help small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs) build an effective workplace response to domestic abuse.

Developed with support from the City of London Corporation (an EIDA Beacon Member), the resource provides a step-by-step guide to help recognise the signs of domestic abuse, respond safely and confidently, and put the right support in place for employees. No prior knowledge is needed, just a commitment to making your workplace a safer place for everyone.



AXA Group developed Safe Spaces, a free online domestic and sexual violence training, available to organisations of any size across the UK. It equips colleagues with the knowledge and confidence to recognise signs of abuse, respond with empathy, and refer victim-survivors to specialist support.
